Welcome to the June 2018 edition of the **angel.london** newsletter

Hello and welcome to our latest newsletter.

Before I progress onto business matters, on behalf of angel.london I would like to offer our sincere condolences to the family and friends of the young man who sadly lost his life in the knife attack on Upper Street this week.

Violent crime is thankfully very rare on the streets of Angel, but the very recent event shows how important it is to be vigilant at all times, and our utmost priority here at angel.london is to work with our Angel Police Team and other strategic partners to ensure the safety of all those who work and live in the BID area. I'm sure you would join me in thanking all the emergency services, council staff and other agencies in their hard work over the past few days; I would particularly like to mention our Angel Police Team who visited over 40 BID businesses yesterday alone to provide reassurance to those most affected.



The last month has again been a busy one for me and the rest of the angel.london team to ensure that Angel is all set for summer and beyond. At the start of the month I met with representatives from TfL to discuss various transportation facilities and services across Angel. Working collaboratively we are exploring a number of opportunities; watch this space for further updates.

I have also had the opportunity to meet with some of our largest employers including Expedia, the Business Design Centre and CBRE to discuss their future plans in Angel. Of course, we don't forget the smaller independent businesses and our residents too; earlier in May we led a workshop with businesses in the Camden Passage quarter 'brainstorming' ideas for events and other activity in the Passage. I've also had the pleasure of meeting representatives from the Charlton Place Residents Committee; its important that we have open dialogue with such organisations that love the Angel as we do.

Finally, as this newsletter goes out, we are pleased to confirm that we have just published our Annual Review 2017/18. Printed copies of the Annual Review will accompany the BID levy bill for 2018/19. This will be sent out to all BID levy payers by Islington Council on our behalf. We have also published the Review on our website; see below for a link to it.
